There are many times in life when you think you have to make that dreaded call to a plumber, when in fact, you might be able to fix the problem yourself, or at least identify what caused it. Here is some foresight that may help you put that plumbing problem into hindsight, either by yourself or with that call to Starving Plumbers.

Water Leaks

So you just got your water bill and it's three times the normal amount. As you accurately surmised, you probably have a major water leak, unless unbeknownst to you a household member has suddenly started taking three hour showers three times a day.

Water leaks can occur anyplace in your plumbing system, from the meter by the street to the last irrigation head in the backyard, and everywhere in between.

If you notice a new pool in the front yard, and don't remember ever installing one, the water service line between the meter and the house is probably leaking. You can test this by turning off the main water shut-off at the house and then check to see if the water meter indicator needle is still moving. If so, the leak is from the water service or possibly from an irrigation system attached to it.

If during your test the meter stops moving, then the leak would be somewhere downstream of your house shut-off valve. Likely sources are running faucets, toilets, leaking water heaters or other appliances, or hot and cold water supply lines within the house. Other exterior water lines and irrigation systems could also be leaking.

If do-it-yourself plumbing repairs are not your cup of tea, you could still save money by having already identified the problem prior to calling Starving Plumbers. And if you can't isolate the leak sources, we can. Leak repair challenges are what we live for. That, and an occasional rib-eye.

Gas leaks

If you smell gas leave the house immediately and call the utility provider from a remote location. If it is absolutely safe to do so, and you know how to shut off your gas meter, you might also do that while you wait for the gas company. Do not turn on any electrical system component. Also, do not surrender to the urge to take up smoking because the gas situation has made you tense. Essentially, do not light any matches.
